Facility Priority Use Statement

"The applicant or organization requesting the use of City/Elworthy Field facilities must be a resident of the Grosse Pointe Public School District or the organization must be located with the Grosse Pointe Public School District or be a public organization providing recreational services to residents of the Grosse Pointe Public School District. Organizations or groups requesting use of City/Elworthy Field facilities must be able to demonstrate substantial local resident participation in order to meet City rental requirements and admittance requirements."

Platform Tennis Reservation and Court Use Procedures

Reservation Procedures

From October 1 to April 30, the City will accept reservations for the platform tennis courts. The courts will be available Monday through Sunday, 8:00 am to 10:00 pm. Members may reserve one court per day for one-and-a-half hours at a time. Reservations may be made up to three days in advance.

To reserve a court, email or call the park office with your request no more than three days in advance. Each weekday, the reservation boards online and at Elworthy Field will be updated at 3:00 pm. The daily reservation deadline for posting will be 3:00 pm, Monday – Friday.

For evening play, reservations must be made by 3:00 pm that day. Reservations for Friday evening, Saturday, Sunday and Monday must be made by Friday at 3:00 pm. Reservations for Saturday and Sunday will not be accepted on the weekends.

Members who wish to play without court reservations can use the courts dependent upon availability. Unreserved courts are available on a first-come, first-served basis. For court availability, check the reservation board online or at Elworthy Field.

When you call to make a reservation or to obtain the access code, you must have your membership number available. Do not give your membership card or number to others to use.

When making a reservation request online, a login account is required and will be set up if provided an email address. All email responses will be sent to that address on the account login.

Schedule Changes

The park office will be closed on the following days and will not accept reservations or update the reservation boards:

Platform Tennis Court Rules and Procedures

All members will be provided with a key card with which to gain access to the courts. These cards are renewable each year, and lost cards will be assessed a \$5 replacement fee. Please do not prop the gate open.

The key for the utilities is stored in the key box mounted next to the door for Court 2. After you open the utility box, immediately return the key to the storage box. This prevents the loss of the key and disruption to other players.

Please reset the combination for the key storage box. This is to prevent unauthorized use of courts and utilities, as well as vandalism and theft.

Make sure that all three padlocks are securely locked. Remember to replace the plastic cover on the bottom of the lock; this helps prevent the lock from freezing.

All court lights must be turned off by 10:00 pm.

The court heaters are to dry the courts, not to be used during play to provide heat.

The equipment locker contains paddles, balls, snow shovels, lock deicer, and other equipment. Please return all equipment after use. If you notice any equipment missing or damaged, please contact the park office as soon as possible.

Reservation Schedule

Reservation requests can be made up to three days in advance. The following chart shows the earliest day that you can send in a reservation request for a particular play time. The weekends are considered one day.
