Applicants must submit a petition signed by 50% of the affected residents to the Public Safety department along with this completed application form.

- Persons in attendance do so at their own peril and the City of Grosse Pointe (nor its agents for employees) will not be liable for personal injury or personal property loss.
- The applicant must place and remove two barricades at each end of the closed roadway, as appropriate, in addition to any "road closed" signing which may be delivered during the date and time authorized. Applicants are responsible for missing and damaged barricades.
- Block party participants must not schedule activities or permit tables, eating, etc. within 100 feet of the intersection roadways and barricades.
- Participants are to comply with the City of Grosse Pointe Noise Ordinance.
- The roadway curb and sidewalk are kept free of all debris and trash resultant from the block party.
- Block party participants will comply with all lawful requests of the Public Safety Department of the City of Grosse Pointe.

Block parties will be approved only during daylight hours.

Block parties will not be approved on Cadieux Road or main thoroughfares.
