



NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

2017 CDBG FUNDED SIDEWALK RAMP REPLACEMENT AUGUST 10, 2017

The City of Grosse Pointe has entered into a Contract with a private Contractor to reconstruct the sidewalk ramps on Charlevoix Avenue at the following intersections:

- Loraine Avenue
- Notre Dame Avenue
- Fisher Road

The contractor plans on starting the project Friday, August 11, 2017. We are anticipating that the project will take approximately 1-2 weeks to complete.

Once removals begin, the sidewalks will be closed to pedestrian traffic at these locations. An alternate route will be required for trips that would take you through these intersections.

If your home is on the corner at one of the locations listed above, and you have a sprinkler system between the sidewalk and curb or along the back of the walk near the corner, please mark your sprinkler heads in this area. This will allow the contractor to attempt to avoid unnecessary damage to your system. Your system will be reinstalled during the restoration phase of the project if damaged. We also ask that you turn off any zone within 20 feet of the corner.

The City of Grosse Pointe wishes to apologize in advance of the impending construction for any inconvenience it may cause you and hopes, with your cooperation, to complete the construction in a timely manner.
