2017 WATER MAIN UPGRADE PROJECT

CADIEUX – KERCHEVAL TO CHARLEVOIX

The week the contractor had more difficulties than they expected getting the new water main across Waterloo but that got completed yesterday. Today the contractor is finishing the installation of fire hydrants and beginning testing the new water main. **Next week the contractor will be finishing the testing and if everything goes well is anticipating connecting the new main to the existing system on Thursday which means that your water will be shut-off on that day. Water is anticipated to be shut off for about 5 to 6 hours beginning around 9am on that day.** Once the connection is made they will begin transferring services. We are still anticipating that pavement restoration will occur during the week of 8/28 in order to open the street to 2 way traffic and have the sidewalks back in place before school starts on September 5th.

To assist the Contractor in completing the water main replacement in as little time as possible, do not park your vehicles on the street between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m.

During construction, mail delivery, rubbish pick-up and access for Emergency Vehicles will not be interrupted.
