



## CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

### FISHER ROAD STREETScape PROJECT

July 6, 2018

This week, Warren Contractors & Development, Inc. began installing the underground electrical lines for the new street lights and installing the new street light bases. Unfortunately they ran into a conflict with an unknown conduit which only permitted them to install the line under Maumee and install conduit to the first light pole base. This conflict was resolved today which will allow work on the light pole bases and new electrical line to continue next week. On a positive note, Warren Contractors was able to complete the majority of the excavation this week.

Next week they plan on continuing with the installation of the new street lights, begin installing sleeves for the new irrigation system, install the water service for the drinking fountain and finishing excavation for the new aggregate base that is planned under the proposed concrete. DTE/Michcon will be installing flow valves on all of the gas service lines on Monday and Tuesday.
