

City of Grosse Pointe Council Goals for 2014-15 (adopted 3/17/14)

TOP PRIORITIES

- Identify, seek approval for, and implement a new funding source for local road funding to address deteriorating street conditions
- By May of 2014, evaluate and provide policy direction to staff on options intended to match City financial resources with public safety expenditures on a long term basis while maintaining essential public safety service levels

HIGH PRIORITIES

- Work to reach fair, timely yet economically affordable employment arrangements with City Employees
- Improve tools and skills to develop new and/or facilitate more effective communication to help explain city services and/or service levels/changes in order to enhance response to customer service type inquiries
- Address the high and escalating costs of retiree health care

ADDITIONAL PRIORITIES

- Support and promote continued public and private investment in Village
- Seek to spur action on development for privately owned large vacant lot adjacent to the Village on St. Clair Avenue adjacent to Lot 4
- Implement the Master Plan rezoning of Fisher Road as Neighborhood Business District and accommodate potential redevelopment there on the south end
- Evaluate the recommendations of the Village parking rate study and take steps to promote customer service and user friendliness of the City's parking system
- Develop a list of and fund projects needed to reinvest in City building and facilities that have had deferred maintenance
