2019 RESURFACING PROGRAM Cadieux and Charlevoix

As part of a road resurfacing grant secured by Grosse Pointe Park and a Maire School safety grant submitted by the City of Grosse Pointe and supported by the City of Grosse Pointe Park, Cipparrone Contracting company has started work on Cadieux Road. The project includes asphalt pavement milling and resurfacing, concrete road rehabilitation, concrete sidewalk and ADA ramps, new concrete curb and gutter, signing, drainage, landscaping, and pavement markings on Cadieux. This project will also include the resurfacing of Charlevoix from Cadieux to Lorraine, paid for by the City of Grosse Pointe. The school safety project will a new sidewalk in front of Maire School to be completed prior to school starting, and include new crossing markings, signage, and other traffic control devices.

Completion of the road improvements is anticipated to be November 15, 2019, barring any unforeseen delays or inclement weather.

The project will be constructed in two stages. During both stages, traffic will be limited toward The Village from Mack. Intermittent stoppages in traffic may also be encountered during construction. Traffic on Charlevoix will be one way toward Grosse Pointe Park.
