



NOTICE TO BUSINESSES
2017 WATER MAIN UPGRADE PROJECT
Notre Dame – Alley at Starbucks to 702 Notre Dame

The City of Grosse Pointe wishes to inform you that they have entered into a Contract with the Bricco Excavating Company to replace and upgrade the water main on a portion of Notre Dame. This project is part of the City's master plan to replace smaller existing mains with larger mains and to loop these mains in a manner that will help increase water flow throughout the city.

The Contractor is expected to begin work on Monday, July 17th. The new water main will be installed under the northbound lane of Notre Dame. The installation of the new water main pipe will begin at the alley behind Starbucks and continue north to the driveway to 702 Notre Dame. Installation of the pipe is expected to take 2 days. During the installation of the new pipe, Notre Dame will be closed to thru traffic at Waterloo and at the alley behind Starbucks. Traffic wishing to access the Kroger parking lot will be directed by signage to the alley off Cadieux as indicated on the attached map or via Waterloo. Traffic wishing to access Lot 2 will be directed by signage to the entrance gate on St. Clair. Access to the Kroger Lot entrance driveway on Notre Dame across from the Board of Realtors will be maintained all throughout during construction. Access to the alley behind Starbucks, the driveway to Parking Lot 2 and the driveway to 702 Notre Dame will be closed for a short period of time while the water main is being installed across the driveways. We anticipate that this will be no longer than 1 hour.

After the water main is installed, the pavement that was removed to accommodate the work will be replaced. A similar closure is anticipated during the time that the pavement replacement work is completed. You will receive another notice prior to this occurring.

After the new water main has been installed and tested, the Contractor will have to connect the new water main to the existing water system at both ends. During this work, the water to your business may need to be shut off. You will be given a minimum of 24 hours notice prior to the water being temporarily shut off. We are anticipating that these planned shutdowns will take up to a half day each, after which time your water will be turned back on. If you have any special needs regarding the water connections process, please contact the City Engineer (below) to discuss the timing and arrangements.

To assist the Contractor in completing the water main replacement in as little time as possible, street parking on that section of Notre Dame will not be allowed. For the businesses on the north side of Kercheval between St. Clair and Notre Dame, you may want to direct your deliveries to come on Kercheval instead of the alley to avoid the construction.

During construction, mail delivery, rubbish pick-up and access for Emergency Vehicles will not be interrupted.
