### **ST. PAUL AVENUE RESURFACING CADIEUX TO FISHER**

This week Pro-Line finished grading and placing the remainder of the stone base on the St. Clair, Lakeland and Washington intersections.

Next week, Pro-Line will complete the placement of the asphalt leveling course on the St. Clair, Lakeland and Washington intersections, and will begin the third and final phase of construction which will include work on St. Paul from Cadieux to Fisher (between the intersections). The final phase will include milling off approximately 3 ½" of existing asphalt surface, base repairs as needed, placement of the first layer of asphalt, capping of the curbs, placement of the final layer of asphalt, pavement markings and restoration.) During this phase, all local cross street intersections will remain open. St. Paul, between the intersections, will be closed to all traffic. This will require residents with driveways on St. Paul to park on one of the local cross streets. Access to Neff Lane will be maintained.
