CONSTRUCTION UPDATE **JULY 29, 2016**

ST. PAUL AVENUE RESURFACING CADIEUX TO FISHER

The contractor was able to complete all of the curb capping on the north side of St. Paul with the exception of the last 2 blocks at the Fisher end even with the hot temperatures.

Next week, the contractor will continue with the curb capping from where he left off today. He is anticipating that he will be at the Fisher end of the project by Monday or Tuesday and will then move to the south side of St. Paul at Fisher Road and continue west back toward Cadieux.

It has been decided to postpone the replacement of the drive approaches on St. Paul until after the final layer of asphalt is placed. You will be notified before this happens.

All local cross street intersections will remain open. St. Paul, between the intersections, will be closed to all traffic on the blocks that the construction is occurring on. This will require residents with driveways on St. Paul to park on one of the local cross streets. Access to Neff Lane will be maintained. Once the curb capping is completed on your block, you will be allowed to access your driveway.
