

NOTICE TO RESIDENTS

2017 WATER MAIN UPGRADE PROJECT

WASHINGTON ROAD - Mack Avenue to Chalfonte Avenue

The City of Grosse Pointe wishes to inform you that they have entered into a Contract with the Bricco Excavating Company to replace and upgrade the water main on your street. This project is part of the Cities master plan to replace smaller existing mains with larger mains and to loop these mains in a manner that will help increase water flow throughout the city.

The Contractor is expected to begin delivery and storage of pipe and miscellaneous materials along the street between the sidewalk and curb during the week of July 3rd. The actual work is expected begin during the week of July 10th and is expected to be completed in early September. Please note your block of the street will also be resurfaced by a separate road contractor after the water project.

Access to your driveways is expected to be maintained at all times during construction. After the water main is installed, pavement patches that were removed to accommodate the work, including miscellaneous sidewalks, will be replaced.

After the new water main has been installed and tested, the Contractor will have to connect the new water main to the existing water system at several locations. During this work, the water to your house will need to be shut off. You will be given a minimum of 24 hours notice prior to the water being temporarily shut off. We are anticipating that these planned shutdowns will take up to a half day each, after which time your water will be turned back on. Then, once the new water main is in service, the contractor will be transferring your individual services from the old main to the new main. This will require water to be shut off to your home for about 30 minutes.

If you are within the construction area and have a sprinkler system along the back of the sidewalk or between the sidewalk and curb, please mark your sprinklers as soon as possible to aid the Contractor in preventing unnecessary damage to your system. If any portion of your sprinkler system requires temporary removal, it will be re-installed during final site restoration and clean-up of the work site.

To assist the Contractor in completing the water main replacement in as little time as possible, the City is asking that you not park your vehicles on either side of the street, or, on your driveway apron between the sidewalk and street between the hours of 7:00 a.m. and 7:00 p.m. once work on your street begins.

During construction, mail delivery, rubbish pick-up and access for Emergency Vehicles will not be interrupted.
