### **NOTRE DAME RESURFACING KERCHEVAL TO WATERLOO**

The City has contracted with Florence Cement Company, Inc. to resurface Notre Dame from Kercheval to Waterloo this summer. The construction is funded by the road Improvement Millage. Beginning the week of July 30<sup>th</sup> (next week), the contractor will begin preparations for the resurfacing of Notre Dame from Kercheval to Waterloo. It is anticipated that this project will take about 4 weeks to complete.

The resurfacing project will include the complete replacement of the storm sewers in the middle of the block, the recapping of the existing curbs, removal and replacement of the concrete parking area along the Maire School field, milling off of the existing asphalt surface, repairs to the existing road base and the placement of a new asphalt wearing surface. This project will also include the removal and replacement of the driveway approaches at 710, 714, 718 and 722 Notre Dame.

During the project, 2 way traffic will be maintained between Kercheval and the alley and 1 way traffic (northbound) will be maintained between the alley and Waterloo. Kroger deliveries and other truck deliveries along the alley will need to exit toward Kercheval.

**The contractor will be working with each of the businesses that have a driveway approach scheduled to be replaced in an effort to maintain access to your parking lots as much as possible.**

To allow the Contractor to perform the pavement repair, no parking will be allowed on Notre Dame. It is absolutely necessary that vehicles not be parked on the street on either side of Notre Dame between Kercheval and Waterloo during the construction.

If you are within the construction area and have a sprinkler system along curb on Notre Dame, please mark your sprinkler heads in this area. This will allow the contractor to attempt to avoid unnecessary damage to your system. If damaged, your system will be repaired during restoration of the project. You will be notified when the placement of the

new asphalt surface is scheduled to take place. When this happens, please turn off your **AUTOMATIC LAWN IRRIGATION SYSTEMS** on the night prior to resurfacing and refrain from cleaning driveways, washing cars, etc.

During construction, mail delivery and rubbish pick-up will not be interrupted.

The City of Grosse Pointe wishes to apologize for any inconvenience it may cause you and hopes, with your cooperation, to complete the construction in a timely manner.
