ST. PAUL AVENUE RESURFACING CADIEUX TO FISHER

Due to the weather and some mechanical issues with the paving machine, Pro-Line was unable to start the paving of the final asphalt surface until this morning. Pro-Line plans on paving today, tomorrow and should finish up on Monday, weather depending.

If you haven't done so already, please turn off your **AUTOMATIC LAWN IRRIGATION SYSTEMS** and refrain from cleaning driveways, washing cars, etc. until the new asphalt surface is placed in front of your house.

Next week, the contractor will be working on removing and replacing drive approaches on St. Paul and completing the sidewalks at the intersections.

When your drive approach is being replaced you will not have access to your driveway and will have to park your vehicle on the nearest side street. Please do not drive on your approach until the barricades and/or caution tape is removed by the contractor. This will happen after the concrete has adequately cured (5 to 7 days). If you drive on your approach before then, you will void the warranty and you will be responsible for any damage that is done.
