ST. PAUL AVENUE RESURFACING CADIEUX TO FISHER

This week Pro-Line finished grading and placing the remainder of the stone base and asphalt leveling course on the St. Clair, Lakeland and Washington intersections. Also completed was the milling off of the top portion of the existing asphalt surface on St. Paul Avenue.

Next week, Pro-Line will continue with the third and final phase of construction which will include work on St. Paul from Cadieux to Fisher (between the intersections). The work next week will consist of pavement base repairs and pavement joint repairs as needed. The placing of the first layer of new asphalt is tentatively scheduled to begin on Monday, July 18th with subsequent capping of the curbs, placement of the final layer of asphalt, pavement markings and restoration. During this phase, all local cross street intersections will remain open. St. Paul, between the intersections, will be closed to all traffic. This will require residents with driveways on St. Paul to park on one of the local cross streets. Access to Neff Lane will be maintained. There shall be **no parking** on St. Paul Avenue for the remainder of the project to allow the Contractor unobstructed access to the work site.
